**Highlight:**

Artificial Intelligence (“AI”) is rapidly transforming the way organizations operate, communicate, manage information and deliver services. For NGOs, AI presents valuable opportunities to improve operational efficiency, enhance service delivery, support data analysis, strengthen reporting, and reduce administrative workload. At the same time, the adoption of AI also introduces new challenges relating to governance, cybersecurity, fraud prevention, data protection, accountability and directors’ responsibilities.

This seminar is designed for NGO Board members, senior management, finance leaders and governance professionals who wish to better understand how AI can be adopted in a practical, responsible and risk-aware manner. Through expert sharing and practical discussion, the seminar will explore how NGOs can make effective use of AI while maintaining proper oversight, protecting personal data, and managing emerging technology-related risks.

The seminar will cover the practical application of AI in NGO operations, responsible AI governance, AI-related cybercrime and fraud risks, data leakage concerns, relevant government and regulatory guidance, and the role of cyber insurance and Directors and Officers Liability Insurance in supporting organizational resilience.

Participants will gain a clearer understanding of how NGOs can develop an appropriate governance framework for AI adoption, strengthen internal controls, improve risk awareness, and prepare for the evolving legal, regulatory and operational expectations surrounding the use of AI.

Mr. Nelson Li Tat Hang is the founder of Loggomatik and a senior management system lead auditor, information security consultant, automation system designer, and AI governance practitioner. With an engineering background from the University of Warwick, United Kingdom, he has built a distinctive professional profile combining certification auditing, industrial automation, information security, AI application, and governance system development.

Nelson was among the early group of professional auditors to obtain the IATF 16949 Lead Auditor grade, establishing his early professional position in automotive management system auditing. He has audited nearly 2,000 organizations across Asia and the United States, and has assisted over 100 companies in achieving ISO certifications. He is a qualified lead auditor with professional qualifications covering ISO 9001, ISO 14001, ISO 45001, ISO 27001, ISO 20000, IATF 16949, and ISO/IEC 42001 Artificial Intelligence Management System.

He received the Best Innovative Tutor Award from TÜV SÜD Academy in 2026, recognizing his contribution to innovative professional training and practical management system education. He was also invited to share his AI application experience at TECHSPO US 2025, and was invited by Camel Battery US as a tutor for management system automation. Over the years, he has served as guest speaker, tutor, consultant, and lead auditor for leading international certification and training organizations, including Moody International, Intertek, DEKRA, and TÜV SÜD.

From 2023 to 2024, Nelson served as Lead Information Security Consultant for D24H Lab of The University of Hong Kong, supporting information security management and governance improvement. Since founding Loggomatik in 2018, he has led automation and management system projects covering audit management, document control, traceability, project tracking, cost forecasting, quotation review, human resources processes, warehouse control, and certification body operation systems.

Nelson was invited to serve as Development Team Lead for A Cube TIC Group in ISO/IEC 42001 scheme development, contributing to the establishment of an Artificial Intelligence Management System certification framework. He was also invited by TÜV SÜD as AI Application Development Leader for ISO audit report review, exploring how AI can support report review, technical evaluation, evidence checking, audit performance assessment, and professional decision support.

Since 2022, Nelson's AI work has focused on risk prediction, report review, technical evaluation, evidence checking, audit performance assessment, and LLM/RAG-based management system intelligence. His current work connects ISO certification, information security, industrial automation, and AI governance, helping organizations move from experimental AI usage toward structured, responsible, and certifiable AI implementation.
